For the Attention of All Residents in the Parish

You will all probably be aware that in May, Cuadrilla will be applying for Planning Permission to drill for shale gas in Roseacre, actually less than 300 meters from the nearest home.

They will also be applying to drill in Little Plumpton and we are worried that their next choice of site could be in the field next to our houses, as we are all living on top of this Bowland Shale.

The negative impact on all of us, is potentially great, with air pollution (from buring off methane gas, during the first two years), water and soil pollution (from possible leaks), noise pollution and vibration (from drilling 24/7 and the many HGVs visiting the site), light pollution (from the floodlit site), and visual intrusion (from the 30 -52 meter high rigs).

We will receive re-assurances about health and environmental risks from the government regulators, but we who live here will have to live with the consequences of any failures.

The obstruction of and noise and fumes from HGVs, on our country lanes, which could yet be coming through Clifton, Treales, Elswick or Wharles to Roseacre, will be significant.

If this concerns you, you must take action.

We will advise you all, when Cuadrilla's application is sent to the Council, so that you may write with your concerns. We will also give details of who to contact and assist if anyone needs help to comply with the planning process. We will have 21 days to put our objections to the council, so please act, at the given time, as all our futures are at stake.
